**COMMUNITY:** The students come primarily from the metropolitan Grand Rapids area, the second largest city in Michigan. This includes the urban, suburban, and rural areas of greater Kent, Ottawa and Allegan counties. The range in socio-economic background is extensive. Thirty-nine percent of students receive need-based tuition assistance totaling over \$1,000,000 given in aid for the 2017-2018 school year.

Course offerings also include 12 additional honors-level classes. Kent Career/Technical Center vocational classes are available in 22 areas.
